Moreover, we distributed the seedling to the villagers.

On 17th Jun, KEG’s staffs went to the Noe Koe Village and we planted the trees with the cooperation of KNPP forest department. That forest name called Mi Kyar So forest and it’s been maintaining from 1950 and they do celebrate that forest traditional festival every 5 years. They do celebrate the forest traditional festival because they believed to get the plenty of crops if they celebrate it. Because Mi Kyar So forest is maintaining the water resources for them. They even do the cleaning fires areas every year there. Today, they do replantation the threes and doing traditional festival at the Mi Kyar So forest areas.

As the KEG had done doing water resources areas, forest areas and replanting the threes at the Wan Nga villages with the cooperation from the villagers. The villagers are much in concerning about the over consumption in cutting trees. Even when they transport the woods they cute the fresh trees. If they are doing like that it’s will not be sustain. So, the villagers are asking help from the KNPP township administrator in solving these issues.
